

FIELD RIFLE FULLBORE

In the endeavour of our club to provide shooting disciplines to satisfy the needs of our members we have decided to introduce the new discipline of "Field Rifle Fullbore".

Simply this means that "Hunting style Rifles" can be used at the 300yd Fullbore shoots under the same regulations that govern "F class open".

Initially the competitors in FRFB must be able to show that their rifle has been sighted in and grouping at 100 yds. No "sighting in at this range is permitted".

There will be two groups of competition shots;

- Rd 1 = 2 sighters +/or 10 counting rounds,
- Rd 2 = 2 sighters +/or 11 counting rounds.

Target shooters will be scored under "F-class" regulations and will be recorded and published as "Field Rifle Fullbore".

If you group consistently at bullseye level or better, you may be eligible to progress to the next range.

Range Fees: same as Fullbore: Visitors \$20, Members \$10.
